Leaves are turning colors and falling, the fields are being harvested, and gardens have finished producing. My garden has been an exception. I've tried to extend the growing season as much as possible by covering plants during frosty nights and trying to protect them during our last freeze. I wonder if any other gardeners are trying to squeeze a bit more into the season as well, or if most have let their seasons finish out. In my case, my harvest tends to be much later than the average person's garden. While others have produce as early as May and June, my garden doesn't generally pick up steam until August. No matter how early I try to start my plants, this just seems to be the way it goes. It sure can be a lot of work, but many peppers are still ripening, so it's worth the effort. I tend to see this in other areas in life as well, not just with my garden. No matter how badly I want something to take root, no matter how badly I want to see the fruit of a particular labor, fruition happens when the timing is right; no sooner, and no later. Have you noticed this too? Sometimes when we feel like we've given just about all the effort we can give, if we hold on a little bit longer, we see the results we've been working towards.

I like to remind myself of how God's timing isn't necessarily my timing. As a matter of fact, God's timing is rarely the same as what I thought it would be. And when I don't remind myself of that, God often gives me the reminder that His timing is not what I expect or anticipate. We're in the middle of the harvest season as we see farmers working day and night to bring in the crops, but we're also in the midst of the Great Harvest that God has employed us all to be a part of. Many have tilled the soil and planted seeds for this harvest. Many have tended the fields and seen the fruit of their labor. What's interesting to note is that this harvest isn't ready because of our timing, and it isn't finished by our timing. It all takes place in God's timing. Keep planting the seeds. Keep tending the fields. Even when you feel like you've given just about all there is to give to see a harvest, keep trusting it is God who makes the seeds grow, and it is the work of the Holy Spirit that ripens the fields.
