Our Conference is comprised of seven states with twenty-one districts within these states. Seven of those districts are in Iowa, and the three districts on the East side of the state just met together for a day-long clergy retreat titled, "Let's Be Methodist Together." Our main discussion topics were about the holiness movement that began with Methodism, how we as the Global Methodist Church can reclaim our heritage as Methodists, how discipleship can become stagnant, and what we can do to revive our work in the Great Commission. It was a day filled with learning and Spirit-led worship, and we also received encouragement to rekindle the connection we have with the churches in our Conference and around the world. These retreats are taking place all across the State, and across the Conference. In the Southeast district, we will work through the possibilities and opportunities of joining together in common mission, in the name of Christ and for God's glory, so we can all be a part of sharing the light of Jesus across the region. I also had the opportunity to attend Annual Conference, and it was just as blessed of a time as it has been since the beginning of the Upper Midwest Conference. Great music, great fellowship, great work together, and significant learning moments. These learning moments included some reminders about how far we've come as a Conference. We have roughly

200 churches within our Conference, comprising of 20,985 members. Average attendance across the Conference is 9,500 on any given Sunday, with another 3,200 joining for online worship. Additional focus was given in the areas of new church plants and congregations that found new places to gather. A vision for our Conference is that every church will be instrumental in church planting by 2030, and there was one statement that really stuck out to me regarding this. I think it's good for all of us to hear, and we'll hear it more than once as the weeks progress. "Jesus didn't ask us to go out and plant churches. He called us to make disciples. If we will make disciples, churches will be planted." That's exciting to me, because it fits right in with our mission statement here in Mediapolis and Sperry of Raising up disciples to love God and reach the world. We will dive deep in conversation with raising up disciples, and I hope you are as confident as I am that through the power and guidance of the Holy Spirit, we will see ways discipleship in the church and with the community around us will bear the fruit of planted faith and planting churches. Have a blessed month as you try to keep cool in this heat and calm in all the hustle and bustle of summer events. I look forward to seeing how we will continue to grow in faith together, and how we will continue to share that faith with the world around us.
